Appraisals

Yes, we appraise Southwestern American Indian Pottery. If you are in the area, you can make an appointment to bring your piece in and we will take the necessary photographs, get the measurements and inspect the condition. We do appraisals from October through May as the summer months find us too busy.

If you are not in the area, you can email us all of the listed information at celia@andreafisherpottery.com.

1. Six photographs: One of each of the four sides, one taken looking down on the top rim and one of the bottom. (If the item is a plate, we only need two photographs, top and bottom.)
2. The measurements: The height and the diameter at the widest point of the piece, please no circumference. A ruler in the photograph is not a substitute for measurements.
3. A detailed description of condition: Including scratches, nicks, cracks and chips.
4. Any additional information: Where purchased, amount paid, family history, etc.

We can tailor our appraisals to meet the specific requirements of your insurance company.

Our appraisal fee is \$100.00 per item. If there are six or more pieces to be appraised, our fee is discounted, depending on the total number and the format your insurance company requires.
